Graduation Survey Summary
June 2, 2021

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Summary:

The 2021 Graduation survey participation rate increased approximately one percentage point from the 2020 survey. Sixty-two graduates responded, yielding a response rate of 15.7%. Based on the participation rate, the results will not necessarily represent the view of the majority of graduates.

The majority of the students who responded rated items concerning their program of study as "very satisfied" and "satisfied." The graduates ranked i) overall quality of campus security, ii) your major program of study, and iii) instruction in your general education courses among their top three levels of satisfaction. Items like campus activities and instruction in your major program of study obtained the highest percentage of "neutral" or "dissatisfied" ratings.

There is a positive feeling regarding ATC's impact on skill development as "very helpful" and "helpful." The highest-scoring areas on this question were:

- 49 percent agree that ATC was "very helpful" in developing skills in oral communication.
- 47 percent agree that ATC was "very helpful" in formulate strategies to identify, collect, analyze, develop, and evaluate information and learn independently.
- 53 percent agree ATC was "helpful" in developing skills utilizing computers.
- 49 percent agree ATC was "helpful" in developing skills in determining personal and career goals and working cooperatively with others.

On the other hand, graduates recognized the following areas of improvement for ATC: i) understanding different philosophies and cultures; and ii) enhancing self-confidence.

The employment results indicate that approximately 60 percent of the respondents were employed at the time of their graduation ceremony. Seventy-two percent of those who responded as employed are working in their program field of study.

Ninety-eight percent of the graduates who answered question six would recommend ATC to someone interested in their education program. Ninety-five percent of the graduates who answered question sixteen would recommend ATC to someone interested in attending college.


Methodology:

The Institutional Effectiveness and Research Department administered the 2021 Graduation Survey via Survey Monkey for Aiken Technical College on behalf of the College's Recruitment and Student Experience Department. On April 5, 2021, a survey link was emailed and texted to 394 graduates. The announcement was also posted on the ATC portal.

This survey was closed on May 3, 2021, at 12:01 am. Sixty-two graduates responded, yielding a response rate of 15.7%. The purpose of the survey is to evaluate ATC's programs as they relate to employment opportunities.

Question 1 asks for contact information and is not included in this report. Results of the Graduation Survey questions 2 - 18 are provided below.







I think that ATC would be a great place to get an education, or at least start going to school at.


Q6. Would you recommend Aiken Technical College to someone interested in your program of study? (Comments cont'd)





Comments

I would not change a thing.

Some of my online classes had no video instruction, it would be tremendously if that was required especially since all of my classes were online due to COVID-19.

Aiken Tech needs to change its advisement system. It was difficult getting an appointment with an advisor, they always claimed to be busy. If you wanted to schedule an appointment with them, the appointment would be weeks later. This is not beneficial at all for the students who do not know how to register for classes by themselves. By the time they get to sit down with the counselor weeks later, the majority of the classes will not have available seats. What really helped is the faculty from USC-A that came to inform the students who were interested in transferring.

I don't have anything to add here.

Job recruiting. Job shops.

Listen more closely to the needs of the students.

One suggestion I have is the bookstore could order more food from Chick-fil-A and Pizza Hut because there were a few times I went to the bookstore and they were all sold out.

When new students come in, advisement should guide these new students better and help them with setting things up and searching for classes for their studies. My first year, my advisor did not give me the correct classes and did not seem to care about my career or the classes I needed. Luckily, I found Ms. Walker and she helped me tremendously. Advisement needs to do more as far as truly caring for their students, like Ms. Walker!

The online parts need some extra steps to make them more user friendly.

As I stated in the early part of the survey, I feel students in the Pharmacy program would benefit more if the classroom was actually set up or remodeled as an actual pharmacy replica to prepare students for the real world and clinicals. I was nervous going into clinical because I didn't know what to expect, our lab was set up different from the actual pharmacy itself. I feel if we had been in a pharmacy setting, it would be an easier adjustment going into a clinicals, or actual job because I would already have an idea as to what it would look like, how it operates, and training would be much more effective if it was done in a Pharmacy setting.

Utilize the kitchen. Perhaps add a culinary program. Create a work study position for the kitchen. Simple stuff. Burgers, hotdogs, sandwiches, side items such as french fries. Also, add a CDL program.
