## *What is the Certified Tower Technician course?*

The Certified Tower Technician course prepares students for entry-level wireless tower technician level one positions. The certification consists of 120 hours of state-funded training in the following areas: Telecommunications Regulations and Standards, Worksite Hazard Awareness, Authorized Climber, Rigging, LTE Installation, Basic Electricity, First Aid/CPR, and OSHA-10. In addition, students will participate in tower climb activities to incorporate skills learned in the classroom setting.
