Associate in Applied Science: Major in Emergency Medical Technology

The program will equip paramedics in the cognitive, psychomotor and affective domains with the knowledge, skills, and confidence necessary to perform in the capacity of an entry level paramedic. The Associate Degree program will prepare individuals to perform advanced level assessments, stabilization, and transportation of sick and injured patients in a pre-hospital environment. This program places a high emphasis on skills and leadership abilities being developed in order to provide quality care in unpredictable environments.

General Requirements (all required documents must be attached for consideration):

- Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age upon completing the EMT Basic courses of the degree program (commonly taught in the second semester of the program).
- Applicants must be physically fit and able to perform the tasks required of an EMT.
- Applicants must be able to be placed in the following General Education courses:
 - a. BIO 112 Basic Anatomy and Physiology.
 - b. ENG 160 Technical Communications.
 - c. MAT 155 Contemporary Mathematics.
- Students admitted to the degree program are required to carry professional liability insurance, which is provided for an additional fee, added to tuition and fees.
- Applicants whose first language is not English must submit official TOEFL scores. A minimum score of 61 on the Internet-based TOEFL is required to be eligible to apply to the program.
- Students admitted to the degree program will be required to complete and pass a criminal background check and drug test prior to clinical rotations. Depending on the result of the background check and drug test, a student may not be able to participate in clinical and will be withdrawn from the program.
- Students admitted to the program must submit documentation for each of the following:
 - a. A physical exam (College form to be provided).
 - b. 2-step TB skin test or chest X-ray.
 - c. Hepatitis B vaccine series, titer, or declination statement.
 - d. Proof of current immunizations, to include seasonal flu.
- Students admitted are required to have reliable transportation for clinical rotations located throughout the community and must be physically able to meet the clinical requirements.
- Applicants must have valid driver's license.
- Applicants will need to have the Program Director's signature on the application prior to submitting.
