Program Description:

The Diploma in Applied Science with a Major in Expanded Duty Dental Assisting prepares the student to work closely with the dentist as a chair-side assistant, office manager, and laboratory assistant, providing preventative and restorative care. The program is accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association. A program graduate may be eligible to take the Dental Assisting National Board Examination to become a Certified Dental Assistant.

General Information:

- Applicants must have completed all required general education courses, BIO 112, and ENG 160, with a grade of "C" or better prior to the application deadline. PSY 105 and MAT 101 must be completed prior to the start of fall semester, with a grade of "C" or better.
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 (**considering all academic course work, including prerequisites, within the last 10 years**). Cumulative GPA will be calculated by ATC personnel upon receipt of application in accordance with the Health Sciences Division guidelines for GPA calculation.
- Credit is awarded for eligible Advanced Placement (AP) coursework, provided valid proof is provided of successfully passing the related AP exam. Credit is also awarded for non-ATC exemption exams such as CLEP or DANTES. No admissions points are awarded for high school AP credit or for successful completion of a CLEP or DANTES examination.
- A criminal background check may be required prior to clinical rotations. Depending on the result of the background check, a student may not be able to participate in clinical and may be withdrawn from the program.
- Students may be exposed to blood-borne pathogens or infectious diseases when in the clinical setting and are required to follow written infection control protocol. Students may obtain a copy of policies associated with blood-borne pathogens and infectious disease by contacting the EDDA Program Coordinator, Mrs. Angela Odom.
- Once admitted to the program, students must submit documentation for each of the following:
 - A physical exam (College form to be provided).
 - 2-step TB skin test or chest X-ray.
 - Hepatitis B vaccine series with antibody titer, or declination statement.
 - Proof of updated immunizations.
 - Current CPR certification (available at ATC/fee required) Online Certification / On Campus Hands on completion.
- Once admitted, students are required to have reliable transportation for clinical rotations. Clinical sites are assigned and are determined by availability at medical/dental facilities. Students are required to purchase uniforms for clinical experiences, have all supplies required, and be physically able to meet the clinical requirements.
- Once admitted, students must purchase liability insurance (cost will be added to tuition and fees).



- Applicants whose first language is not English must submit official TOEFL scores. A minimum score of 78 on the computer-based exam is required to be eligible to apply to the program. English as a Second Language (ESL) courses are strongly recommended.
- Applicants must be physically able to meet the requirements of all clinical areas.
- Attach all college transcripts to application.
- After the application date has passed, all applications meeting the minimum requirement are reviewed by the Expanded Duty Dental Assisting Admissions Committee. Spaces are allotted to those most qualified as determined by the point system on this application.
- Candidates earning equal points are ranked based on their cumulative GPA.
- Clinical rotations are required in Health Sciences and Nursing programs. Clinical sites may request students to follow protocols beyond what is required by Aiken Technical College, including COVID-19 vaccination.
