Program Description:

The Medical Assistant Certificate program prepares the student to assist the physician in performing selected diagnostic tests as well as business office procedures. The Medical Assistant Program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (www.caahep.org) upon the recommendation of Medical Assistant Education Review Board (MAERB).

General Information

- Applicants must have a **high school diploma or GED** and be at least **18 years of age** (unless participating as a dual enrollment student prior to high school graduation).
- Applicants must have submitted an **application for admission** to the College.
- Applicants must have completed all required **transitional education** courses with a grade of "C" or better.
- Applicants must have a cumulative institutional GPA of 2.0 or higher (**considering all academic course work, including prerequisites, within the last 10 years**). Cumulative GPA will be calculated by ATC personnel upon receipt of application in accordance with the Health Science Division guidelines for GPA calculation.
- Applicants must earn a grade of "C" or better in all general education courses.
- No advanced placement, transfer credit, or credit for experiential learning will be awarded for any of the major course requirements for the Medical Assistant program which have "MED" as the course prefix.
- Once admitted, students must earn a grade of "C" or better in all program courses to continue.
- Once admitted, students will be required to complete and pass a **criminal background check** and **drug screening** to be scheduled by the Health Sciences Division. Depending on the results of the background check and drug screening, a student may not be able to participate in clinicals and will be withdrawn from the program.
- Once admitted, students are required to have **reliable transportation** for clinical rotations. Clinical sites are assigned and are determined by availability at medical facilities. Students must be **physically able** to meet the clinical requirements.



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- Once admitted, students must purchase **liability insurance** (cost will be added to tuition and fees).
- Once admitted to the program, students must **submit documentation** for each of the following (details of the below will be provided at orientation and shouldn't be completed prior to acceptance into the program):
 - A physical exam (College form to be provided).
 - Students may be exposed to blood-borne pathogens or infectious diseases when in the clinical setting. Students may obtain a copy of policies associated with bloodborne pathogens and infectious disease by contacting the Medical Assisting Program Director, Crystal Driesen.
 - 2-step TB skin test, QuantiFERON blood test, or chest X-ray.
 - Hepatitis B vaccine series, titer, or declination statement.
 - Proof of current immunizations, to include seasonal flu.
 - Current CPR Certification (Must be taken through ATC/fee required).
- Applicants whose first language is not English must submit official **TOEFL scores**. A minimum score of 78 on the TOEFL iBT exam is required to be eligible to apply to the program. English as a Second Language (ESL)
- Applicants must be physically able to meet the requirements of all clinical areas.
- Attach all college transcripts to application, including ATC transcript.
- After the application date has passed, all applications meeting the minimum requirement are reviewed by the Medical Assisting Program Director. Spaces are allotted to first applied, first qualified.
