Diploma in Applied Science: Major in Surgical Technology

The Diploma in Health Science with a Major in Surgical Technology program prepares the student for entry-level employment as a Surgical Technologist in medical facilities. Upon successful completion, the student is eligible to take the national certification exam administered through the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting. This program is accredited by the Accreditation Review Council on Education in Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting.

General Requirements (all required documents must be attached for consideration)

- Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
- Applicants must have completed AHS 102, BIO 112, and BIO 225 with a grade of “C” or better.
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 (**considering all academic course work, including prerequisites, within the last 10 years**). Cumulative GPA will be calculated by ATC personnel upon receipt of application in accordance with the Health Sciences Division guidelines for GPA calculation.
- Applicants must complete the Application Checklist, attach supporting documentation, and submit to the Enrollment Services Center prior to the application deadline. All information requested must be attached or the application will be considered incomplete. Incomplete applications will not be considered for admissions.
- Credit is awarded for eligible Advanced Placement (AP) coursework, provided valid proof is provided of successfully passing the related AP exam. Credit is also awarded for non-ATC exemption exams such as CLEP or DANTES. **No admissions points are awarded for high school AP credit or for successful completion of a CLEP or DANTES examination.**
- To start the Surgical Technology program, the student is required to have completed ENG 160, PSY 105, and MAT 101 with a grade of “C” or better.
- Once admitted, students will be required to complete and pass a **criminal background check** and **drug screening**. Depending on the results of the background check and drug screening, a student may not be able to participate in clinical and will be withdrawn from the program.
- Once admitted to the program, students must **submit documentation** for each of the following:
 - A physical exam (College form to be provided)
 - 2-step TB skin test or chest X-ray
 - Hepatitis B vaccine series with antibody titer, or declination statement
 - Proof of current immunizations
 - Current CPR certification (available at ATC/fee required)
- Once admitted, students are required to have **reliable transportation** for clinical rotations. Clinical sites are assigned and are determined by availability at medical facilities. Students are required to **purchase uniforms** for clinical experiences, have all **supplies** required, and be **physically able** to meet the clinical requirements.
- Once admitted, students must purchase **liability insurance** (cost will be added to tuition and fees).
- Applicants whose first language is not English must submit official **TOEFL scores**. A minimum score of 78 on the TOEFL iBT exam is required to be eligible to apply to the program. English as a Second Language (ESL) courses are strongly recommended.
