Information and Application for Fall 2023

Program Description:

The Associate in Applied Science with a Major in Surgical Technology will provide students with the surgical technology skills needed for employment in medical facilities. Upon successful completion, the student will be eligible to take the national certification exam administered through The National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting (NBSTSA).

General Information:

- Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
- Applicants must have completed ENG 160 (or ENG 101 & SPC 205), MAT 101, BIO 101, BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, AHS 102, SUR 123, SUR 125, SUR 126 and PSY 105 (or PSY 201) with a grade of “C” or better. Only the first or second attempted grades of the prerequisite courses taken within the last 10 years will be considered. The grade of a “W” or “WF” will count as an attempt. Please refer to the program display.
- To apply to the Surgical Technology program, the student is required to have completed ENG 160, PSY 105, MAT 101, AHS 102, BIO 210, & BIO 225 (or acceptable substitutions for ENG 160, PSY 105, MAT 101), with a grade of “C” or better. The remaining courses can be in process when application is submitted. All courses MUST be completed prior to starting the program (Prior to the 1st day of class in the fall).
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 (**considering all academic course work, including prerequisites, within the last 10 years**). Cumulative GPA will be calculated by ATC personnel upon receipt of application in accordance with the Health Sciences Division guidelines for GPA calculation.
- Credit is awarded for eligible Advanced Placement (AP) coursework, with valid proof of successfully passing the related AP exam. Credit is also awarded for non-ATC exemption exams such as CLEP or DANTES. **No admissions points are awarded for high school AP credit or for successful completion of a CLEP or DANTES examination.**
- To start the Surgical Technology program, the student is required to have completed ENG 160, PSY 105, MAT 101 (or acceptable substitutions for ENG 160, PSY 105, MAT 101), SUR 123, and SUR 125 with a grade of “C” or better. SUR 123 and SUR 125 can be in process when application is submitted.
- Once admitted, students will be required to complete and pass a **criminal background check and drug screening**. Depending on the results of the background check and drug screening, a student may not be able to participate in clinicals and will be withdrawn from the program.

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- Once admitted to the program, students must **submit documentation** for each of the following:
 - A physical exam (College form to be provided).
 - 2-step TB skin test or chest X-ray.
 - Hepatitis B vaccine series with antibody titer, or declination statement.
 - Proof of all other current immunizations or titers (Varicella, Tdap- within 10 years, Influenza, MMR).
 - Current CPR certification from the American Heart Association (available at ATC/fee required).
- Once admitted, students are required to have **reliable transportation** for clinical rotations. Clinical sites are assigned and are determined by availability at medical facilities. Students are required to **purchase uniforms** for clinical experiences, have all **supplies** required, and be **physically able** to meet the clinical requirements.
- Once admitted, students must purchase **liability insurance** (cost will be added to tuition and fees).
- Applicants whose first language is not English must submit **official TOEFL scores**. A minimum score of 78 on the TOEFL iBT exam is required to be eligible to apply to the program. English as a Second Language (ESL) courses are strongly recommended.
- Attach all college transcripts to application.
- After the application date has passed, all applications meeting the minimum requirement are reviewed by the Surgical Technology Admissions Committee. Spaces are allotted to those most qualified as determined by the point system on this application. Students who have all courses completed and meet all requirements will be considered before other applicants.
- Candidates earning equal points are ranked based on their cumulative GPA.
- Clinical rotations are required in Health Sciences and Nursing programs. Clinical sites may request students to follow protocols beyond what is required by Aiken Technical College, including COVID-19 vaccination.
