

Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class B

WHAT TYPES OF VEHICLES MAY BE DRIVEN WITH A CLASS B?

- Straight trucks
- Large buses, such as city buses, tourist buses and school buses
- Segmented buses
- Box trucks, including delivery trucks and furniture trucks
- Dump trucks with small trailers

PRE-REQUISITE REQUIREMENTS FOR CDL CLASS B PROGRAM

- Must be 18 years of age or older and possess a valid driver's license
- CDL Part B Permit
- Department of Transportation Physical (Long Form) obtained from Doctor's office or other healthcare practice.
- Official 10 Year Driving Record (from Department of Motor Vehicles)
- Pass and submit a drug/alcohol screen along with the Chain of Custody form
