## 2. Off-Campus Instruction at Midland Valley High School

Summary of Issue: The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) has a Substantive Change Policy for colleges changing anything operationally. In 2016 the College received SACSCOC approval to offer 25-49% of an Early College program on the

Midland Valley High School (MVHS) Campus. The College submitted a prospectus to SACSCOC on September 1, 2021, to request approval to offer 50-100% of an Early College program off-site at MVHS. SACSCOC approved the prospectus in December 2021, allowing the College to offer an entire program of courses at MVHS. The College plans to implement the expanded program(s) in fall 2022.

Dr. Burdette added in August 2021, the College submitted notification to offer 25-49% of program instruction at Aiken, Ridge Spring-Monetta, Silver Bluff, and South Aiken Christian Baptist High Schools. The College continues to build its Dual Enrollment programs.
