Methodology

The annual Graduate survey was administered to graduates immediately prior to the graduation ceremony in the spring of 2017. The purpose of this survey was to evaluate ATC's services. A total of 99 out of 407 graduates responded to the survey for a response rate of 24%. Questions 1-6 ask for contact information and are not included in this report. My biggest issue with Aiken Tech would be the change to printing services. Seriously, ATC doubled the price and removed the printers from the class rooms. Doubling down on the stupidity of that move, many people go to the library to print. Those computers are especially vulnerable to key logger software waiting for credit card information to be stolen. Not only does it take an address, name, and CC number but the code on the back of a card to add credits, but the personal information being saved on public computers is staggering. Its a disaster waiting to happen to some innocent or naive person. Follow that up with the bookstore. Not only are prices for books not available online but only in select windows. Furthermore, the details and I use that word loosely about the books are not always accurate. Books for the next semester for the most part should be available at the beginning of advisement for Math, English and nursing and possibly other classes. I can understand not having information on rare classes at the start of advisement even though im sure the middle man selling the books has the prices on hand. Every student has to take Eng and Math so there is no reason not to be prepared since when advisement periods are open knowledge on the ATC calendar. Lastly, if you want future students to actively participate in student related activities, stop only sending information through the student email. I have been attending ATC over two years most of the time I don't even bother checking it. I can assure you that I am not alone in this sentiment. Many of my fellow students feel the same way. I already have a work email, a personal email and now you want me to have a school email too? Most of the activities around school I learned about through teachers. I would not have even known I had to apply to graduate if not for Mr. White telling me. I am sure the plan to inform students through email would be much more effective if you actually sent us a email to an account we use. Not to mention that if in the future there are events at aiken tech we will still know about them because our old student email will be abandoned after it stops being useful.

My program needs improvement with labs.

Offer more courses

One thing I would suggest as far as the Computer Technology's Programming and Networking curriculum are concerned is to introduce courses that would offer more business savvy to the graduates allowing them to be able to sell what they can make instead of having to figure it out, having to work through the inevitable failures after they get through college and need to pay off the debt, or just eat and have a place to stay.
