Admission Information for Fall 2017 and Spring 2018

Emergency Medical Technician: Advanced Certificate

This academic credit program provides instruction and practice in dealing with medical and traumatic emergencies. Graduates of the Emergency Medical Technician program will be eligible to challenge the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians' (NREMT) practical and written certification examinations and are immediately employable upon certification.

*Start dates are dependent upon having an adequate number of eligible applicants.

General Requirements (all required documents must be attached for consideration)

- Applicants must have completed an approved **EMT Basic course** and have a current, unencumbered **EMT Basic license** and SC Reciprocity or a provisional to be eligible for admission into the Emergency Medical Technician: Advanced Certificate.
- Applicants must meet the requirements for **placement into MAT 110** (College Algebra).
- Students must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) (**considering all academic course work, including prerequisites, within the last 10 years**). Cumulative GPA will be calculated by ATC personnel upon receipt of application in accordance with the Health Sciences Division guidelines for GPA calculation.
- Once admitted, students will be required to complete and pass a **criminal background check**. Depending on the results of the background check, a student may not be able to participate in clinical and will be withdrawn from the program.
- Once admitted, students are required to have **reliable transportation** for clinical rotations. Clinical sites are assigned and are determined by availability at medical facilities.
- Once admitted, students are required to **purchase liability insurance** for clinical experiences and be **physically able** to meet the clinical requirements (cost will be added to tuition and fees).
- Once admitted to the program, students must **submit documentation** for each of the following:
 - A physical exam (College form to be provided)
 - 2-step TB skin test or chest X-ray
 - VDRL
 - Hepatitis B vaccine series, titer, or declination statement
 - Proof of current immunizations, to include seasonal flu
 - Current CPR certification (available at ATC/fee required)
- Applicants whose first language is not English must submit official **TOEFL scores**. A minimum score of 61 on the Internet-based test (iBT) is required to be eligible to apply to the program. English as a Second Language (ESL) courses are strongly recommended.
