

It is the policy of Aiken Technical College to provide a healthy, safe, and secure environment for all students, employees, and visitors.

The College will comply with requirements of the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990 and the statutes of the S.C. Code of Laws relating to security services. Campus Security personnel will exercise law enforcement authority on College property as granted in State Code and will develop and maintain close working relationships with local law enforcement agencies. Officers who have been certified through the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division shall be authorized to carry firearms on campus. Adequate coverage by Campus Security will be maintained as deemed necessary by the administration and may be accomplished through either full or part time College positions or through contracted services. All security personnel must have appropriate training and supervision.

In addition to the enforcement of law, Campus Security shall also enforce College policy with regard to prohibited activities, whether or not criminal in nature.
